

DE-ANNEXATION ORDINANCE NO. 88-1

AN ORDINANCE EXCLUDING LAND LYING WITHIN THE PRESENT CITY LIMITS OF CROUCH, BOISE COUNTY, IDAHO, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE EXCLUDED TERRITORY OF THE CITY OF CROUCH, BOISE COUNTY, IDAHO, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ACTING MAYOR AND COUNCIL ~~OF THE~~ CITY OF CROUCH, BOISE COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION 1: That all land lying outside of Section Fifteen, Township Nine North, Range Four East shall be and is hereby de-annexed from the said City of Crouch, Idaho, limits and that said de-annexed property shall be excluded from said City of Crouch, Idaho, and hereafter be outside the city limits of the said City of Crouch, Idaho.

SECTION 2: The above described property is more commonly known as the one (1) foot wide strip of land down the highway to and including the Ponderosa Inn at Banks II.

SECTION 3: The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published in one (1) issue of the Idaho World, and posted in at least five (5) public places of the city; within thirty (30) days from the date of the passage and approval hereof. Proof of publication of said ordinance shall be filled therewith in the City Files; and a certified copy of said ordinance shall be filed with the Recorder, the Auditor, the Treasurer, and the assessor of Boise County; and with the Idaho State Tax Commission.

SECTION 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances, insofar as they are in conflict, shall be and the same are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

SECTION 5: Public readings will be April 6, 1988; May 2, 1988 and June 6, 1988.
