

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-005

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE IN THE CITY OF CROUCH, IDAHO;  
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Crouch, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 50-302 is empowered to impose reasonable limitations and regulations to protect the general welfare and safety within the city limits and

WHEREAS, the City of Crouch has determined that adopting a uniform law for regulations preventing conditions hazardous to life and property by fire or explosion is in the best interests of the welfare and safety of the citizens and businesses in the City of Crouch;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROUCH, IDAHO, as follows:

Section 1: INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE AND STANDARDS:

There is hereby adopted by the city for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion, that certain code and standards known as the international fire code, 2003 edition, including all amendments adopted as state law, and the international fire code standards. One copy of the current edition of the international fire code, appendix chapters and the international fire code standards are on file in the office of the City Clerk and the same are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein; and from the effective date hereof, the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the city.

Section 2: PENALTY:

Any violation of this ordinance, by businesses or residence, shall be an infraction as defined in Idaho Code 18-111, punishable by a penalty not to exceed \$100.00 per violation.

Section 3: SEVERABILITY:

If any provision or section of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such provision or section shall be considered separately and apart from the remaining provisions or sections of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the Idaho World.
