Member CS made the Motion to approve the Consent Agenda, Member AB seconded, Motion passed. All members-yes.

**• Water Issues**

- (\*) Water Master Report: Pine Grove Lots 3,4, & 5 are going to have their water hook up engineered. They are all covering the costs. Terry is recommending that all homeowners have this done. Council approves this hook up.

**• New Business**

(\*) North Fork Challenge concerns- Jody explained that they are covering all bases for event. Porta potties and dumpsters will be placed around town. Last year they gave out trash bags to people and this worked very well. Crouch was kept clean. They are working on Police presence as they have the money in their budget for this. Very willing to work with us. Food trucks will be coming in as well. The Shame will be providing extra porta potties, 12-14. The park boundary was explained by attorney. It appears part of the park is city and part county. This is being explored more. Jody said they have the Mass Gathering permit.

Council member Smith would like to see a events area for the City of Crouch. On Agenda for next meeting.

- (\*) Application of reconsideration for Senior Center: Barb presented her opposition to the Council's decision on the re-zoning from last Council meeting. The vacant lot is located by 3 other businesses and only 1 residence. The lot has been treated as commercial by the HOA. She originally wanted it re-zoned to Mixed-use and she may consider that again but was unhappy that it has been treated as commercial. Motion was made by SM to reconsider the zoning of the Senior Center. AB Seconded. Roll call: All Yes. A Public Hearing will be held at our next Council Meeting. Notice to be published in the paper.
- (\*) City Boundary Discussion: Geoff will do some checking in the County Records to establish the exact boundary of the park as to being partially in the city or all Boise county. Argument was tabled until more information can be established.
- (\*) Political signs: Some signs have been pulled up and taken. We need to watch out for this.

- **Old Business**

- (\*) Speed Limit Monitoring-update: Member McAninch said the parts to add lights to our existing signs were very expensive. Curtis Fry will check into the portable speed monitoring unit. Maybe able to pick up one for a lot less. Crosswalks painted on the road was suggested but that places a liability on the city.
- (\*) New computer update: We tried to order a computer, Costco cancelled it, will re-order.

- (\*) Road Committee Report: Paving/filling holes. The Old Crouch Merc had the pot holes in front of the business patched. The bridge here in Crouch is not rated so there are no restrictions.
- (\*) Crouch/Garden Valley Museum Board Report: Kim Bosse would like to help get a Museum board together. She will get names from the Mayor and work on this.

- **Unscheduled Delegation:**

Jim Trudeau wants his water line extension in. He was advised that Terry Tucker is who he needs to contact for this. Jim was told he may need it engineered but he needs to contact Terry. The discussion got a little heated and again he was told to contact Terry.

Tim Fritzley-they are working on utility lines, water lines and sewer. They will bring in the forms when this is completed.
