- **Consent Agenda**
 - Review of Minutes of Regular Meeting of May 10th, 2023
 - Review of Payables & Financials
 - (*) Approve Consent Agenda-Member CS made a Motion to approve the Consent Agenda, Member LA Seconded the Motion, All- Yes Motion passed.
- **Water Issues**
 - (*) Water Master Report-Council made the decision to use a specific water meter. Member SM made a Motion to use the Census Smart Water Meter, Member LA Seconded the Motion, Motion passed.
- **New Business**
 - (*) Garden Valley Fire Dept Impact Fees-Bill Llevenberg from GVFD informed the Council that they have done the study and the development committee. They are doing an intergovernmental agreement. The Fire District has to have one with the City and County. It will deal with a whole lot of Idaho Statutes. They implemented a pass through fee where the City and County collect the fees and passes it on to the Fire District. The City of Crouch can do an intergovernmental agreement. They will get a copy to Geoff as soon as they can. Geoff said the City has to appoint an Impact Advisory Board which will require a zoning ordinance and a 15 day hearing notice. Question was asked what will the approximate fees be? \$1687 on all brand new residential and commercial building.
 - (*) Discussion/decision on Mayor Schiefelbein’s appointment of Mike Hefner and Shawna Martin to the City Council. Mayor spoke about his choice of Mike Hefner as a new City Council member. Member LA made the Motion to approve the Mayor’s appointment of Mike Hefner. Member SM Seconded the motion. All- Yes. Motion

passed. Mike Hefner was sworn in by the Mayor. Council member Louis Archer submitted his resignation as Council member. Member SM made the Motion to accept the resignation of Louis Archer. Member CS seconded the Motion. All-yes. Motion passed. Mayor introduced Shawna Martin to appoint for the remaining open Council seat. Member CS made the Motion to accept the Mayor's appointment of Shawna Martin. Member SM seconded the Motion. All-yes. Motion passed. Mayor swore Shawna Martin in as new Council Member.

- **Old Business**

- (*) Boise County Sheriff Patrol 4th of July-They will patrol with no fee.
- (*) Chamber of Commerce- The Mayor spoke to Dr. Ballou and the Pastor at Calvary. Dumpster placement at GV Smiles is ok and a port a potty at Calvary is ok. Soap Box Derby is moving forward, they are 95% ready to go. They have 4 cars, working on two more. They are planning on having it on a part of Old Crouch Rd by the Library, not the whole road.

- (*) Road Committee Report- Special Meeting-Road Survey outcome- Steve R. had sent out 7 inquiries for surveyor's. No one has responded back with a bid for survey. He had set 6/16/2023 as a deadline date. Forsgren-no bid. Steve asked how Council would like to proceed? Mayor asked for the list of surveyor's. One company who replied to us needs all the legal property information. We need to get something done! -per Mayor. Mayor asked how long we should give a company to respond? Average 21 days. Steve said he can call all of them back to see if they are interested in this project. We will need an itemized list of exactly what we need them to do. Steve will call and we will have to go from there.
- (*) Crouch/Garden Valley Museum Board Report- Kim was absent. City Clerk relayed for her. Matt Sanders is donating his time and building a handicap ramp at the Tucker building. The Museum Board is still working on sorting and logging items. Going slow but good.

Member CS went over how well our new Speed Limit signs are working! He would like to get the smiley face on our signs. He will donate the \$90 for them if the company won't donate them. Maybe we could send a Thank you card.
