• **Consent Agenda**

- Review of Minutes of Regular Meeting of June 8th, 2022
- Review of Payables & Financials
- (*) Approve Consent Agenda
Member: SM made the Motion to approve the Consent Agenda, Member: AS second,
Roll Call: AS-Y, SM-Y, LA-Y Motion passed.

• **Water Issues**

- (*) Water Master Report-None
- (*) Introduction of new Water Master- George Simpson introduced himself. He said our water system is good but growing. We are in compliance with the state. He will need to go over the operation of water plant as well. Meters will need to be up to spec. Meters should be about 5' deep to insulate them from freezing, although these are harder to read. Some can be read by a scanner. Some of the water meters will show a leak very quickly which is very helpful. He would like to go over some things in his contract. He will meet with the Mayor or Steve McAninch. George also needs a key to the water plant.

• **New Business**

- (*) Lot Split- Jim Trudeau was present for the meeting. The Mayor and Council had no problem with the lot split. The findings of the Council for the lot split were read.
Member: SM made the Motion to approve the Lot Split, Member: AS second the Motion, Roll Call vote: AS-Y, SM-Y, LA-Y, Motion passed.
- (*) Property Line adjustment-Caughlin's were not present at the meeting. The findings of The Council were read. Member: SM made the Motion to approve the Property Line Adjustment. Member: AS second the Motion. Roll Call vote: SM-Y, AS-Y, LA-Y Motion passed.
- (*) Reimbursement to Senior Center- Council discussed reimbursing the Senior Center for their re-zoning fee. Member: LA made the Motion to reimburse the Center \$100 for one of the re-zoning applications, Member: SM second the Motion for \$100.

Roll call vote: SM-Y, AS-Y, LA-Y Motion passed.

(* Establish a Museum Board- Kim Bosse was not present, nothing on a Museum Board yet.

- **Old Business**

- (*) Speed Limit Monitoring-update: Keith K. said he has lived here 10yrs and has tried to get something done with speeders. More speed limit signs were suggested. Mayor will speak to Keith after the meeting. The BC Sheriff said there is not enough help. Steve McAninch said over the 4th of July officers gave out a lot of tickets. Keith said since the majority of Boise County lives in Garden Valley, we should get some more help. Mayor said he may call Boise County tomorrow. Shawna Warcy said they fly by her house. The City Ordinance for noise is 2:00AM. Advised people to call the non-emergency # for speeders.

- **Unscheduled Delegations**

It was suggested that garbage cans around the city would be nice. People are throwing trash on the ground. Maybe Project Patch, School kids, Community Service or Chamber of Commerce could help.

Thor Oden gave back 6 EDU's to the city. The city was paid for 4 of them and he never received the money for them. He had pre-paid for them and was to receive money. Member: SM made a Motion to pay Thor Oden \$8000 for the EUD's sold by the City of Crouch. Member: LA second the Motion. Roll Call vote: SM-Y, AS-Y, LA-Y

Motion passed to pay the \$8000 to Thor.

On a separate issue, there were billings from Mnt Water works to Thor and the city. Around \$2000 was paid. Will need to do research on what these were for and who was responsible for paying the fees.

Tim Fritzly would like a copy of our Water Ordinance. The question of how many EDU's are required for residences, business etc. The city water is not to be used to water lawns.

Patricia Nelson has stepped down from helping as a city planner. The Mayor has a lead on another one.

Jim Trudeau asked how many days before the meeting can a person be placed the agenda?
