The people who will have meters installed will be carrying those who do not have them. May cost about \$2000 a meter to have them installed. Need to get with the Mtn Water Works engineer. We are not using our tank to capacity.

They have no more money for our city. We can purchase more speed limit signs for Crouch but Geoff explained that they need to be official. Boise County would have to give us the authority to put these signs up, we must be within the law. Boise County must know where the signs would be placed to be a valid speed limit area.
