

ORDINANCE 2019-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CROUCH, IDAHO, REPEALING ORDINANCE 2016-03; AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 3.1.5 “LICENSE APPLICATION” OF THE CROUCH CITY CODE, BY PROVIDING THAT THE CITY CLERK MAY SIGN AND APPROVE VENDOR LICENSES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City of Crouch is a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, the City of Crouch is authorized by Idaho Code §§ 50-301, 50-302, and 50-307 to promote the general welfare of the City and to enact ordinances regulating and licensing occupations and businesses within the city limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Crouch desire to update regulations relating to approving business licenses within the City limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CROUCH, BOISE COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance 2016-03, enacted on September 14, 2016, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: That Title 3, Chapter 1, Section 3.1.5, “LICENSE APPLICATION” of the Crouch City Code be, and hereby is, amended as follows:

3.1.5 LICENSE APPLICATION

Application for a business ~~or vendors~~ license shall be in writing, on a form ~~prepared approved~~ by the City Clerk and ~~approved by~~ the Mayor of Crouch, Idaho, signed ~~and sworn~~ by the applicant. ~~Application for a vendors license shall be in writing, on a a form prepared and approved by the City Clerk, signed by the applicant.~~ The City Clerk shall prepare license forms for licenses issued under this ordinance. The licenses shall specify the holder’s name, the type of business licensed, the principal place of business of the licensee and the expiration date of the license. The City Clerk shall account for all licenses signed by the Mayor, shall countersign the licenses and deliver the licenses to licensees. The City Clerk shall collect and record and shall issue a receipt for said fees. The initial business license issued to licensee pursuant to this ordinance shall be for the period from date of issuance to December 31, of the same calendar year.

Section 3: Severability: Provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions. The remaining sections of Title 4 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: Effective Date: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.

Section 5: Publication: In lieu of publication of the entire ordinance, a summary of this ordinance may be published in compliance with Section 50-901A, Idaho Code.


